

The Kate Moyna-O'Sullivan memorial fun run and walk will take place at Inch beach on Sunday evening, 27th of June, starting at 7pm. There is no entry fee for the event but those who wish to do so are asked to make a donation to the Kerry palliative care home help team. A well known and much loved member of An Ríocht AC Kate competed for the club with distinction in road races and mountain running championships. She passed away in January of this year.

Masters Men - 100m, 400m, 3000m, High Jump, Long Jump, Shot Putt, 56lb wf, 4X100m relay

Masters Women - 100m, 3000m, Long Jump, Shot Putt, 4X100m relay.

Many of the athletes competing at this event will be in action in the weeks after at national Senior, Juvenile or Masters Championships and it offers a great opportunity to see some of the county's recent high performers at Schools and provincial level.

The England Aviva Track & Field Championships & World Trials at Bedford International Stadium doubled, for the first time ever, as the Irish 20km race walking championships. In the Junior 10km walk Emma Prendiville of Farranfore Maine Valley had an excellent race to finish 3rd in what was a close finish by the top three athletes. Niall Prendiville was in action in the gruelling U23 20km and set a new pb of 1 hour 42.50.
