

Munster Juveniles 2010

The Munster juvenile track and field championships concluded last weekend in the CIT in bishopstown in glorious weather. Even with a lot of athletes missing due to exam commitments a huge haul of over 170 medals returned to Kerry along with an incredible seven championship records. Over the four days of competition there were five standout athletes namely Eoin O Carroll Tralee harriers, Ailbhe Courtney and Clarence Kennedy St Brendan's, Adam King Iveragh and Emma Prendiville Farranfore mainevally.

Eoin took four gold in the U16 long jump, triple jump, high jump and 250m hurdles, two silver in the 100m and 200m and had records in the long jump with 6.26m and triple jump with 12.92m; for good measure he was also very close to the record in the 250m hurdles. Ailbhe Courtney finished with five gold in the U19 100m hurdles, 400m hurdles, 200m, 400m and triple jump, one silver in the long jump and a Munster record of 15.74 in the 100m hurdles; also for good measure she finished fractionally outside the 400m record in 58.7. Clarence Kennedy took three gold in the U18 110m hurdles, triple jump, pole vault, two silver in the long jump and shot with a Munster record in the 110m hurdles in 15.49. Adam King competed in two events the U14 hammer and discus and won both with ease while setting a record in the hammer with a throw of 40m plus. Emma Prendiville was as always dominant in her speciality the race walk and coasted to victory in a new record of 15.12 mins. Last but not least the Tralee harriers boys U16 relay beat the old record held by another Kerry club Lios tuathail with a fantastic time of 47.56 with a team of Fearghail O Nuallainn, Danny Pierce, Eoin O Carroll and Danny Pierce.

Other standout athletes and performances include Sinead O Connor Tralee harriers, Mel O Callaghan Gneeveguilla, Christine Cooper Spa muckcross, Mary Fitzgearld An Riocht, Darragh McDonnell Estuary, Niamh Clifford Star of the Laune, Iarla Courtney St Brendan's, Tom O'Suilleabhain Farranfore, Brian O Seanachain Lios tuathail and Cillian O Donovan Iveragh but to name a few.
